Mitchell College is searching for an adjunct professor who can teach general introductory level Spanish language courses, on-site. The ideal candidate would have an MS or Ph.D. and a teaching background that includes instruction of students with diverse learning styles. Working under the general direction of the Humanities Department Chair, this position is part-time (variable hour) and renewable each semester based on the College's enrollment needs.
