#### GENERAL SUPPLIES:

## TECHNOLOGY:

## LAPTOP CONFIGURATION EXAMPLES:

#### Dell Latitude E5570 configuration example:

- Intel Core i7-6600U (dual core, 2.6GHZ, 4MB cache)
- Windows 10
- AMD Radeon R7 M360 2GB graphics card minimum
- 8GB memory minimum
- 128GB SATA Class 20 solid state drive minimum
- Dual band wireless adapter and bluetooth
- Non-touch screen (This example does not have a touch screen but you may wish to have a touch screen)
- Camera and microphone

#### MAC laptop configuration example:

- 8 GB memory minimum
- 256GB flash based storage minimum
