Mitchell College Spring 2021 Registration Notes:

1. Registration begins on Monday, November 9 and continues through Friday, November 20.
2. To qualify to register, a student must be enrolled at Mitchell during the Fall 2020 (current) semester. The student must also have their account “up-to-date” with payments for the current term and have no holds.
3. Students are asked to please refer to 2020-2021 Mitchell College Catalog course descriptions that include **necessary prerequisites**. The catalog can be found on-line at the student’s portal (Registrar links). Students may be removed from a class administratively if they do not meet the specified prerequisite.
4. The codes used for days of the week in the class schedule listing is as follows:
M = Monday, **T** = Tuesday, **W** = Wednesday, **R** = Thursday, **F** = Friday.
5. Due to COVID-19 we are offering 3 Modes of Delivery (MOD) for our classes. Remote Delivery (RL), Hybrid/Blended (H/B) and In Person (P).
 - **In person (P)** - class meets in person, in the room assigned for all scheduled meeting times throughout the semester in session I (with the exception of the first two weeks) which will be delivered online. In person classes must meet social distancing guidelines.
 - **Remote Learning (RL)** - class is entirely online, but requires synchronous instruction for all or part of the semester.
 - **Hybrid/Blended (H/B)** - class meets in person for approximately half of the scheduled meeting times, but has major online components which may be mostly synchronous but may have some asynchronous components. Not all students may be able to be accommodated in the classroom at the same time during in person meetings.
6. Full-time students make an appointment with their Academic Advisor in advance and will register for courses with the Advisor at that appointment. Part-time students are encouraged to meet with their Academic Advisor BEFORE registering for classes at the Registrar’s Office. The Bursar’s Office requires that part-time students must pay for courses at the time of registration.
7. Part-time students are also charged an additional course fees for all Science lab courses, all Graphic Design courses, and computer courses.
8. Course times, days and instructors are subject to change depending upon college needs. Some courses may be cancelled if insufficiently enrolled at the conclusion of registration or during the summer months.
