Judicial sanctions are meant to assign accountability, ensure the safety of the College community and provide an opportunity for students to learn from their mistakes and make better choices in the future.

The sanctions below may be modified or changed.

COVID-19 Violation	Violation, Definition and Sanctions
Improper Use of Mask	Wearing a mask improperly
1 <sup>st</sup> Offense: Warning	Meeting with RHD/Judicial Hearing Officer and mutual agreement for behavioral change
2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense: <b>Warning</b>	Restorative Justice Sanctions:  • \$100 fine or  • 4 hours community restitution or  • Research project
3 <sup>rd</sup> Offense: <b>Disciplinary Probation</b>	Placed on disciplinary probation
4 <sup>th</sup> Offense: Suspension/Removal	COVID-19 Committee hearing for suspension or removal from housing
Absence of Mask	Not wearing a mask on Mitchell College property in any shared space on campus, both indoors and outdoors.
1 <sup>st</sup> Offense: Warning	Meeting with RHD/Judicial Hearing Officer and mutual agreement for behavioral change
2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense: <b>Warning</b>	Restorative Justice Sanctions:  • \$200 fine or  • 6 hours community restitution or  • Research project
3 <sup>rd</sup> Offense: <b>Disciplinary Probation</b>	Placed on disciplinary probation.
4 <sup>th</sup> Offense: <b>Suspension/Removal</b>	Official COVID-19 Committee hearing for suspension or removal from housing
Unauthorized Guest	Hosting a guest who is not a resident of your Residence Hall. Visiting a Residence Hall in which you do not reside. Commuter student in any Residence Hall or unauthorized area for Commuters on campus.
1 <sup>st</sup> Offense: <b>Warning</b>	Meeting with RHD/Judicial Hearing Officer and mutual agreement for behavioral change and; Restorative Justice Sanctions:  • \$100 fine or  • 4 hours community restitution or  • Research project
2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense: <b>Disciplinary Probation</b>	Restorative Justice Sanctions:  • \$250 fine or  • 8 hours community restitution or  • Research project
3 <sup>rd</sup> Offense: <b>Suspension/Removal</b>	Official COVID-19 Committee hearing for suspension or removal from housing.

Large Social Gatherings/Parties	Exceeding the allotted number of guests permitted per room/suite.
1 <sup>st</sup> Offense: Suspension/Removal	Official COVID-19 Committee hearing for suspension or removal from housing and; Restorative Justice Sanctions:  • Host: \$500 fine • Guests: \$250 fine
2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense: <b>Removal/Expulsion</b>	Official COVID-19 Committee hearing for removal from housing or expulsion from the College
3 <sup>rd</sup> Offense: <b>Expulsion</b>	Official COVID-19 Committee hearing for expulsion from the College
Quarantine/Isolation Violation	Non-Adherence to guidelines provided for Isolation and Quarantine
1st Offense: Warning	Meeting with RHD/Judicial Hearing Officer and mutual agreement for behavioral change
2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense: <b>Disciplinary Probation</b>	Restorative Justice Sanctions:  • \$250 fine or  • Research project
3 <sup>rd</sup> Offense: <b>Suspension/Removal</b>	Official COVID-19 Committee hearing for suspension or removal from housing
<b>COVID Violation Sanctioning</b>	Partial or Non-completion of the assigned sanction
1 <sup>st</sup> Offense: <b>Disciplinary Probation</b>	Placed on disciplinary probation Restorative Justice Sanctions:  • Completion of original sanction and \$100 fine or • 6 hours community restitution or • Research project
2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense: <b>Suspension/Removal</b>	Official COVID-19 Committee Hearing for suspension or removal from housing and; Restorative Justice Sanctions:  • Completion of original sanction + \$200 fine or  • 9 hours community restitution or  • Research project
3 <sup>rd</sup> Offense: <b>Expulsion</b>	Official COVID-19 Committee hearing for expulsion from the College.
Violation of College issued COVID-19 Guidelines	Including, but not limited to, non-compliance with mandatory testing; not reporting off campus travel according to College travel policies in place; not maintaining social distancing; not following posted signage; not logging symptoms in CoVerified App
1st Offense: Warning	Meeting with RHD/Judicial Hearing Officer and mutual agreement for behavioral change
2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense: <b>Warning</b>	Restorative Justice Sanctions:  • \$200 fine or  • 6 hours community restitution or  • Research project
3 <sup>rd</sup> Offense: <b>Disciplinary Probation</b>	Placed on disciplinary probation
4 <sup>th</sup> Offense:	Official COVID-19 Committee hearing for suspension, removal from
Suspension/Removal/Expulsion	housing or expulsion from the College.
