



Mitchell College Off-Campus Travel for Resident Students*

▶ **The College strongly discourages non-essential off campus travel for resident students until further notice.**

All students should avoid traveling anywhere – whether in state or out of state – to spend time with any persons who are currently sick, quarantining or awaiting COVID test results. All students should continue to follow the [Mariner Promise](#).

LEAVING THE CAMPUS

Students **who choose to travel** off campus for **5 days or more** and then return to campus, must complete and submit the [College Travel Acknowledgment Form](#) and comply with the following procedures.

Document Travels	Submit College Travel Acknowledgment Form using password: Mariners2021. Student should also keep apprised of state requirements here .
Symptom Check	Do not return to campus if you have tested positive for COVID-19, are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 (https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/symptoms-testing/symptoms.html) or were, in your travels, knowingly exposed to anyone diagnosed with COVID-19, quarantining or awaiting COVID-19 test results.
Returning to Campus	All students returning to campus must submit prior to return a negative SARS-COV2 Viral PCR test taken within 72 hours prior to their return to campus. Submit through the CoVerified app. Returning students must also re-enter the weekly on-campus COVID-19 testing pool. Schedule via the CoVerified app.
