The catalog can be found on-line at the student's portal (Registrar links). Students may be removed from a class administratively if they do not meet the specified prerequisite.
4. The codes used for days of the week in the class schedule listing is as follows:  
**M** = Monday, **T** = Tuesday, **W** = Wednesday, **R** = Thursday, **F** = Friday.
5. Full-time students make an appointment with their Academic Advisor in advance and will register for courses with the Advisor at that appointment. Part-time students are encouraged to meet with their Academic Advisor BEFORE registering for classes at the Registrar's Office. The Bursar's Office requires that part-time students must pay for courses at the time of registration.
6. Part-time, non-matriculating students are also charged an additional course fees for all Science lab courses, all Graphic Design courses, and computer courses.
7. Course times, days and instructors are subject to change depending upon college needs. Some courses may be cancelled if insufficiently enrolled at the conclusion of registration or during the summer months.
