Mitchell College Guidelines for Bringing Your Own Devices:

- All systems should have the latest Operating System (OS) or (iOS - for Macs)
- We are agnostic of brands - with the exception of Chrome Books, which we **DO NOT** recommend
- All systems should have an active Antivirus (free or purchased)

- iPads and tablets are welcomed for personal use **BUT** they are **NOT** used in place of laptops for academics.

Laptop configuration examples:

Dell Latitude E5570

- Intel Core i7-6600U (dual core, 2.6GHZ, 4MB cache)
- Windows 10
- AMD Radeon R7 M360 2GB graphics card minimum
- 8GB memory minimum
- 128GB SATA Class 20 solid state drive minimum
- Dual band wireless adapter and bluetooth
- Non-touch screen (*This example does not have a touch screen but you may wish to have a touch screen*)
- Camera and microphone

MAC laptop configuration example:

- Macbook Air 13.5 inch
- Intel Core i5, dual core 1.6 GHZ processor
- Intel graphics card 6000
- 8 GB memory minimum
- 256GB flash based storage minimum
