### Mitchell College Guidelines for Bringing Your Own Devices:

- All systems should have the **latest Operating System (OS)** or (iOS - for Mac’s)
  - o We are agnostics of brands - with the exception of Chrome Books which we **DO NOT** recommend
- All systems should have an active **Antivirus** (free or purchased)
  - o Avast can be downloaded for free from [www.avast.com](http://www.avast.com)
- iPads and tablets are welcomed for personal use, **BUT they are not used in place of laptops for academics**
- Laptop configuration **examples**:
  - o Dell Latitude E5570
    - Intel Core i7-6600U (dual core, 2.6GHZ, 4MB cache)
    - Windows 10
    - AMD Radeon R7 M360 2GB graphics card minimum
    - 8GB memory minimum
    - 128GB SATA Class 20 solid state drive minimum
    - Dual band wireless adapter and Bluetooth
    - Non-touch screen (This example does not have a touch screen, but you may wish to have a touch screen)
    - Camera and microphone
  - o MAC laptop configuration **example**:
    - Macbook Air 13.5 inch
    - Intel Core i5, dual core 1.6 GHZ processor
    - Intel graphics card 6000
    - 8 GB memory minimum
    - 256GB flash-based storage minimum

### Art Supplies:

It is recommended that you bring typical craft/art supplies with you. This would include scissors, tape, glue sticks, assorted construction paper, markers, etc. Art supplies are good for being creative, designing projects for classes or for a club, or developing flyers to help you or your friends run for the Student Government Association, for example.
