



Mitchell College Promise [Pilot Program] New London County Application

Mitchell College’s New London County Pilot Promise Program is intended to enable the Office of Admissions and the Office of Financial Aid to enhance financial aid packages for selected students.

Program Goals

- Increase access for students by making college more affordable at a rate that is competitive for New London County residents
- Enhance student experience by providing students with the benefit of on-campus living, including community engagement, convenience, and access to resources for a more engaged college experience

Eligibility Requirements

- Graduate from a New London County high school in 2025 with a 2.5 or higher GPA
- File a FAFSA
- Be accepted to Mitchell College
- Submit a Mitchell Promise application
- Live on campus and actively participate in Mitchell’s community outreach throughout their college experience
- Maintain a GPA of 2.5 or better at Mitchell College

Benefits*

- Tuition and Fees—Fixed at \$20,000 per year for 4 consecutive years
- Housing and Food for On-campus Residency—Fixed at \$10,000 per year for 4 consecutive years

*Acceptance into the Mitchell Promise Program option replaces/voids other Mitchell College financial aid offers.)
