- 2. To qualify to register, a student must be enrolled at Mitchell during the Spring 2025 (current) semester. The student must also have their account "up-to-date" with payments for the current term and have no holds.
- 3. Students are asked to please refer to 2024-2025 Mitchell College Catalog course descriptions that include **necessary prerequisites**. The catalog can be found on the website at https://mitchell.edu/college-catalog/. Students may be removed from a class administratively if they do not meet the specified prerequisite.
- 4. The codes used for days of the week in the class schedule listing is as follows:
 - **M** = Monday, **T** = Tuesday, **W** = Wednesday, **R** = Thursday, **F** = Friday.
- 5. Students schedule a registration appointment with their Academic Advisor through Insight and will register for courses with the Advisor at that appointment.
- 6. Part-time, non-matriculating students are also charged an additional course fees for all Science lab courses, all Graphic Design courses, and computer courses.
- 7. Course times, days and instructors are subject to change depending upon college needs. Some courses may be cancelled if insufficiently enrolled at the conclusion of the registration period.
